This is the entrance on Pancras Square.

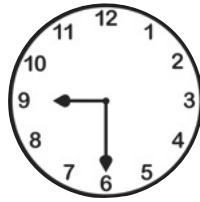


This is the entrance on Pancras Road.

There are large print and paper copies available too.

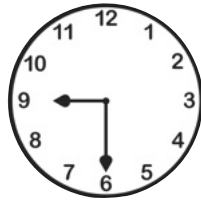


The wifi networks are:

There are no passwords.

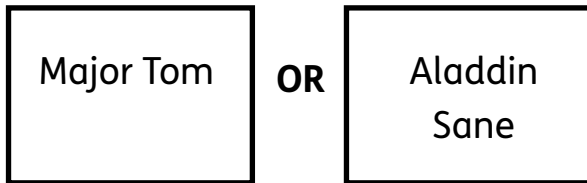


There is a free breakfast of coffee, teas, orange juice, water, fruit, pastries and jam.

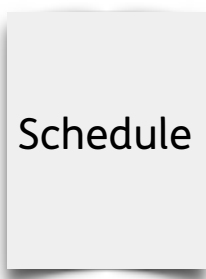


9:30am

Events are in either Major Tom or Aladdin Sane.



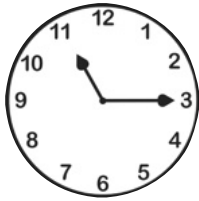
The summit schedule will tell you which one.



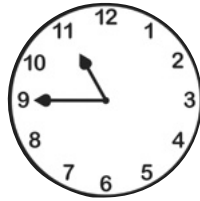
You can choose where to sit.

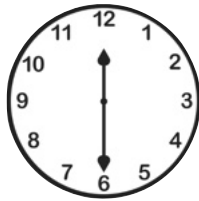

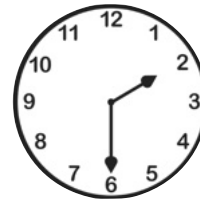
There is a morning break at 11:15am until 11:45am.

2:30pm

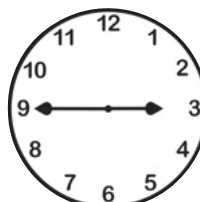
There is a lunch break from 12:30pm until 2:30pm.



For lunch you can choose from fish, beef, pumpkin, salad, pasta and bread and butter.



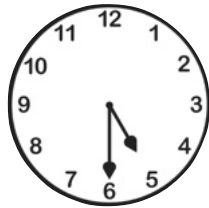

There is coffee, teas, orange juice, water, fruit and biscuits.

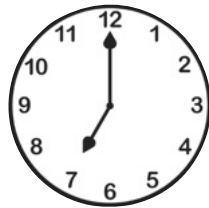

Getting Here and Access



Kings Cross St Pancras station is a 5 minute walk.



46 and 63 busses stop at Kings Cross St Pancras.

This is a 6 minute walk.



17, 91 and 259 busses stop at Kings Cross Station/York Way.

This is a 7 minute walk.



390 bus stops at Goods Way.

This is a 6 minute walk.



The Google London taxi drop off entrance is on Pancras Road.



The nearest multi-story car park is JustPark on Pancras Road.

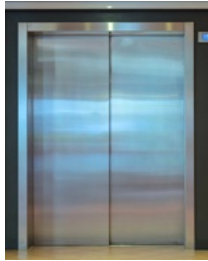
There are 2 Blue Badge parking bays on Goods Way.



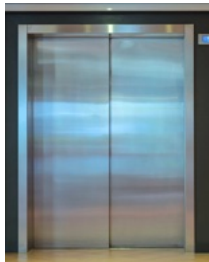

The lift dimensions are 166cm wide and 230cm deep.

with chairs and fidget tools.



The Quiet Room can be used if you are feeling anxious or overwhelmed.



It can also be used for prayer or milk-pumping.



The OKRE staff wear branded t-shirts.



You can ask them for help and directions.
